ORDER

The above-styled action is before the Court on Defendant's Motion for Attorney's Fees.

A Final Decree of Divorce was entered in this action November 14, 2007. Therein, both parties were given 15 days from the date of the order to submit letter briefs on the issue of attorney's fees. On November 28, 2007 Defendant submitted a brief outlining the lengthy procedural history of this case and Plaintiff's conduct throughout. It does not appear to the Court that Plaintiff has submitted a response.

After considering Defendant's brief, citation to authority and a review of the entire record, Defendant is hereby awarded attorney fees in the amount of FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS [\$40,000]. This award is pursuant to both O.C.G.A. § 19-6-2 and O.C.G.A. § 9-15-14(b) as this court finds Plaintiff's conduct to have unnecessarily expanded the scope of these proceedings. Such amount shall be paid within 10 days of the date of this order.
