**CHILD SUPPORT ADDENDUM**

The parties have agreed to the terms of this order and this information has been furnished by both parties to meet the requirements of O.C.G.A. §19-6-15. The parties agree on the terms of the order and affirm the accuracy of the information provided, as shown by the their signatures at the end of the this addendum.

X This addendum includes findings of fact and conclusions of law made by the court, in compliance with O.C.G.A. §19-6-15.

**Application of Child Support Guidelines.** The statutory requirements of O.C.G.A. §19-6-15 have been applied in reaching the amount of child support provided under the final order of this Action. The specifics are as follows:

1. **Gross Income** -  
The Father's gross monthly income (before taxes) is \$6,649.60  
the Mother's gross monthly income (before taxes) is \$1,666.67 (imputed)
2. **Number of Children** - The number of children for whom support is being provided under this order is (1).
3. **Attachments** - The *Child Support Worksheet and Schedule E* are attached and made a part of this addendum, along with any other applicable schedules.
4. **Child Support Amount** - The Mother shall pay to the Father for the support of the minor children, the sum of Six Hundred One Dollars (\$601.00) per month, beginning on December 1, 2007,
5. **Duration of Child Support** -  
X (a) **Beyond Age 18 for High School:** The child support shall continue monthly thereafter until each child reaches the age of eighteen, dies, marries, or otherwise becomes emancipated; provided that if a child becomes eighteen years old while enrolled in and attending secondary school on a full time basis, then the child support shall continue for the child until the child has graduated from secondary school or reaches twenty years of age, whichever occurs first.
